

Purpose:

The Beautification Committee is a 5 member board appointed by the City Council. Each member serves a 2 year term.

The purpose of the Beautification Committee is to oversee and make recommendations to the City Council regarding the beautification and the aesthetics of the City.

Staff's responsibility is to advise and give guidance to the Beautification Committee Members through the process of making council reports and findings.

Duties:

Beautification Committee Members are responsible for:

- O**rganizing volunteers to complete projects,
- R**esearching projects and presenting them to the City Council for consideration,
- M**aking improvements to landscaped areas owned by the City,
- R**ecommend to the Parks & Recreation Commission for park site amenities and improvements,
- P**ower and authority to make recommendations and advise the City Council and the Planning Commission in horticultural matters, beautification, and trees. (Ord. 571)
