

- The Board cannot under any circumstances incur any indebtedness against the City of Patterson or any of the funds of said City without the consent of the City Council.

- The Board shall have the power and authority to enlist the assistance of such other persons as the Board may deem necessary to accomplish the powers and duties assigned to it, such persons to serve at the pleasure of the Board, without vote.
