NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City of Patterson (“City”) City Council will hold a Regular Meeting on **Tuesday, October 17, 2023, at 7:00 p.m.**, in person AND via video conferencing and Zoom teleconference, to consider the following:

Public Hearing: Transportation Infrastructure Master Plan

The City of Patterson has undertaken preparation of a series of Master Plans addressing infrastructure and public service needs. One of these Master Plans, for Transportation Infrastructure, has been completed by City consultants, and will be presented to the City Council for adoption. The Transportation Infrastructure Master Plan addresses needs based on long-term plans for City development under its adopted General Plan, including standards for meeting needs of the current and future population, a blueprint for expanding, improving and protecting the City’s existing and future circulation systems, and strategies for addressing needs. As part of this action, the City has also prepared an Addendum to the 2010 General Plan Environmental Impact Report pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.

Public Hearing: City of Patterson Regional Transportation

Notice is hereby given that the City Council of the City of Patterson will conduct a public hearing on October 17th, 2023 to consider approval of a resolution approving a Regional Transportation Impact Fee report and adoption of revised fees. Government Code Section 66000 allows local governments to adopt fees charged to new development for the purpose of providing infrastructure and facilities necessary to serve such development. State law also requires that the adoption of such fees be supported by evidence which relates the cost of such infrastructure and facilities with the impact to such facilities caused by the development upon which the fees are charged. This evidence is provided by the Regional Transportation Impact Fee report. The report and resolution do not constitute a project under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) (Public Resources Code section 21062; CEQA Guidelines section 15375(b)(4)).
