



ARPA Community Survey

The City Council is seeking input from the community on ideas to assist with Patterson's economic recovery and encourages you to take a brief survey.

The City of Patterson will receive a total of \$5,388,220 in American Rescue Plan Act funding. \$4,194,790 of the total amount of funds have been appropriated thus far leaving \$1,193,430 to still allocate.

Cities can use ARPA funds for:

1. Responding to the COVID-19 Pandemic
2. Covering costs incurred from the public health emergency
3. Replacing lost, delayed, or decreased revenues to local governments due to COVID-19
4. Addressing the negative economic impacts on local businesses and nonprofits
5. Making investments in water, sewer, or broadband infrastructure

The amount already appropriated has been for programs or projects within all five categories but the City is interested in hearing from its residents regarding ideas for use of the remaining \$1,193,430.
